July Competition ~ Black and White

Our July competition is BLACK AND WHITE... not to be confused with Monochrome.

Monochrome photography is a form of photography where images are captured and displayed using a <u>single colour</u>, or <u>shades of a single colour</u>, instead of a full spectrum of colours. This often involves black and white images, but can also encompass images using other single colours, like blue or green. The focus in monochrome photography is on values, textures, and contrast, rather than on colour.

Black and white photography, also known as grayscale or monochrome photography, is the art of creating images using a range of tones from pure black to pure white, with varying shades of gray in between. These images <u>lack any colour</u> and are characterized by their focus on light, shadow, and texture.

This is a <u>Tewantin Shield Set Subject</u>, so we must stick to the definition.


