
There is also a meeting fee of \$5 per member, per club night.

Those who have attended these in the past say it's a great day with lots of laughs! Hope you mark it on your calendar so you can attend!

We plan to carpool, so meeting at the clubhouse at 7.30-7.45 so we can leave at 8am sharp. Or you can also meet us at the Caboolture Historical Village by 9am.

- 9.45 -12.00 Photography around the Village.
- 12.00 12.45 Lunch (Lunch will be at 12.00 for those who are purchasing from the Village, and any-time for those who bring their own.)
- 12.45-2.00pm Photography around the village.
- 2.00-2.30 Finish up (cuppa and chat), The Village is open until 4, and everyone is welcome to stay
 if they choose.



Morning Tea, tea & coffee will be supplied. There is specialty coffee available at the Redhill Cafe at the entry, at your own expense.

The village requires how many will be attending on 16th, by the Friday 7th March. Please email the club if you are planning to go.

SEQ: Salon of Excellence Old is... ***OPEN***

The Salon of Excellence (SEQ) is being hosted by the Rockhampton Photography Club this year. The competition closes on Sunday March 30th, but if sending prints they should arrive the Friday before (28th) and because they are going to Rockhampton, you should post at least a week before.

There are 2 grades, A and Non-A Grade, where you enter according to the grade you are in club. C & B grade members enter into the Non-A Grade section.

There are 6 subjects, in both Digital and Print:

- OPEN COLOUR
- OPEN MONO
- PORTRAIT (COLOUR or MONO)
- NATURE (COLOUR or GREYSCALE MONO)
- SOCIAL DOCUMENTARY (GREYSCALE MONO ONLY)
- ELEMENTS (COLOUR ONLY)

Here's what YOU can be awarded!

- Gold Medallions will be awarded to the overall Champion in A Grade and Non-A Grade Print and Digital categories.
- Silver Medallions are awarded to the Winner of each Category not receiving a Gold Medallion.
- First, Second and Third place in each category will receive a Certificate.

Here's what the CLUB can be awarded! (So let's get some entries in from our club!)

- Club with the highest total points (Angus Buchanan Trophy)
- Club with the highest average points (minimum 5 entrants) (Stewart Parker Trophy)
- Club with the most acceptances (Dalby Photographic Society Shield)

Entry rules and subject definitions will be sent with the newsletter.

ENTRY FEES

- The entry fee is \$10.00 for the first section and \$5.00 for each additional section.
- IE: 6 Sections = \$35 / 12 Sections = \$65.00
- Maximum of 4 images may be entered in any one section.
- Entry fees are to be paid via Paypal on the website.
- Entry fees are non-refundable.

Bunnings Sausage Sizzle



Judging will be on October Prac Night, the 20th.
