

2026 Set Subjects

MONTH & SUBJECT	DEFINITION
FEBRUARY Bokeh & Open (Tewantin Shield)	Out of focus highlights that are pleasing to the eye. The image may have a subject in focus for interest, but the bokeh must be the majority of the image.
MARCH Minimalism & Open (Qld Interclub)	Image making that relies on simplistic compositions, heavy use of empty space and elimination of clutter. The main subject is often kept small in the frame or its presence kept to a minimum and exceptionally simple.
APRIL Nautical & Mono Open (Qld Interclub)	Relating to ships, sailors, sailing and navigation of the sea.
MAY Serenity & Open (Tewantin Shield)	Portray a quiet, peaceful scene, being untroubled, a state of calm
JUNE Social Interclub	Upload up to 15 images (preferably in a theme) and email club your collection Title. These will be put to music in a slideshow and presented on the night along with images from other clubs' members in attendance.
JULY Red/Touch of Red & Open	The image can be mostly red in colour, or a touch of red, but making sure the focus of red in the image really captures the attention of the viewer.

MONTH & SUBJECT	DEFINITION
AUGUST Kitchen <i>& Mono Open</i>	<p>We all have a kitchen. This theme can be basically any photo taken in a kitchen or a photo of anything that can be found in a kitchen. For example, people cooking or washing dishes or seated around the kitchen table enjoying a meal. Although the image may include food, it should complement the scene and not be the primary subject of the photograph.</p>
SEPTEMBER Texture <i>& Open</i>	<p>A picture of a subject where the surface of which is shown to good advantage by a light source coming from a shallow angle to the surface.</p>
OCTOBER Connections <i>& Open</i>	<p>A ‘connection’ can be a relationship in which a person, animal or thing is linked or associated with someone, some others or something else. For instance, connection could be when two or more people interact with each other and each person feels valued, seen and heard. We also see animals, birds and insects connecting with each other and the things around them. Or a connection could be as simple as an electrical plug being pushed into a socket!</p>
NOVEMBER Rural Life <i>& Mono Open</i>	<p>Rural is defined as “of or relating to the country, country people or life, or agriculture.”</p>
